

# Bergen-Hudson-Passaic Area Economic Summary



Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector





Over-the-year change in the <u>prices paid by urban</u> <u>consumers</u> for selected categories


## 12-month percent change in CPI-U, December 2023


