


# Employment in Hurricane Storm Surge Flood Zones, Broward County, FL



| Area           | Establishments | Average Monthly Employment | Total Quarterly Wages |
|----------------|----------------|----------------------------|-----------------------|
| Zone 1         | 209            | 1,078                      | 9,296,201             |
| Zone 2         | 700            | 3,958                      | 55,969,090            |
| Zone 3         | 2,219          | 27,239                     | 297,848,998           |
| Zone 4         | 3,774          | 32,731                     | 406,233,213           |
| Total Included | 6,902          | 65,006                     | 769,347,502           |
| Unincluded     | 56,680         | 627,192                    | 6,770,374,428         |

Note: Flood zones represent a conservative estimation of areas that would experience flooding in the event of a hurricane. Zone 1 is the area that would be flooded by a Category I hurricane. A Category II hurricane would cause flooding in Zones 1 and 2. The hurricane categories reference the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Scale.
