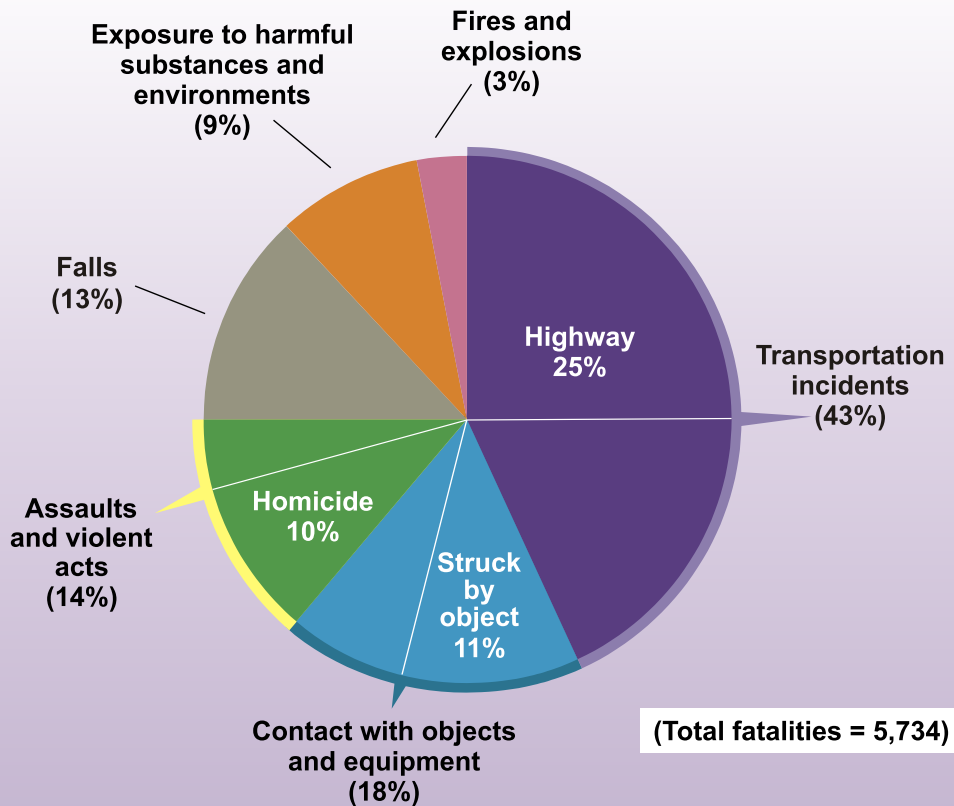
Fatal work injuries result from a number of different types of events. Highway incidents alone accounted for 1 out of every 4 fatalities in 2005.

Falls accounted for another 13 percent of the fatal injuries incurred in 2005.

Workers who were fatally injured after being struck by an object accounted for 11 percent of all fatal work injuries, while homicides accounted for 10.
