Falls accounted for about 13 percent of fatal work injuries from 2003 to 2005.

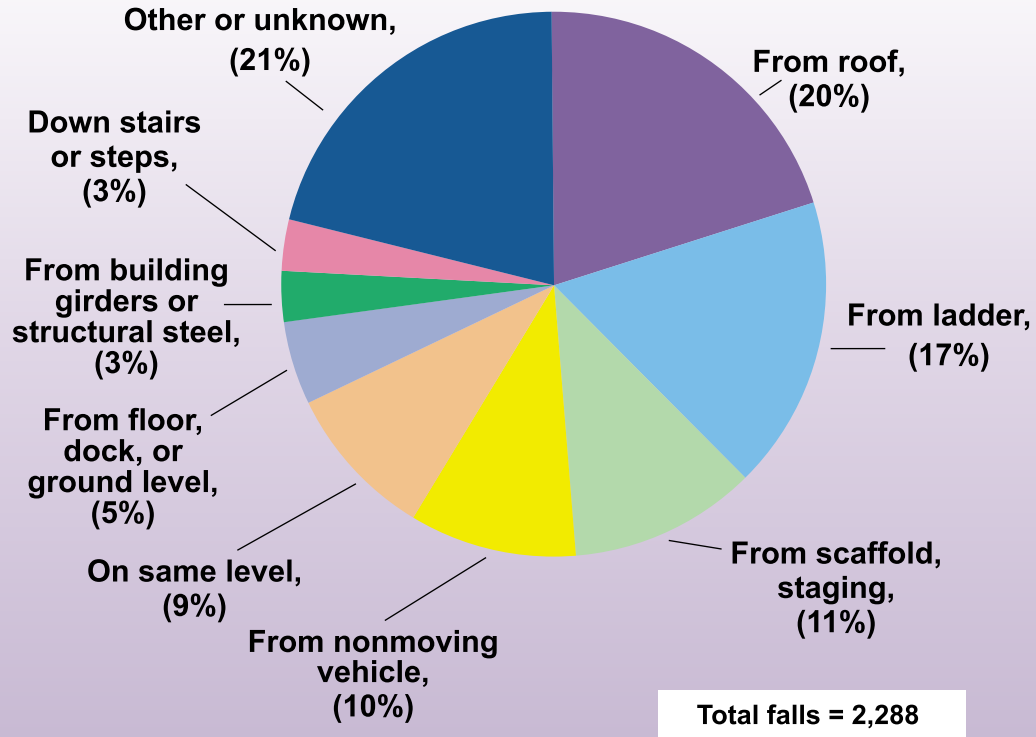
Of the 2,288 fatal falls during this period, one-fifth were falls from roofs and one-sixth were falls from ladders.

Falls from scaffolds and staging, falls from nonmoving vehicles, and falls on the same level each accounted for about one-tenth of fatal falls.
