Half the cases involved more days and half involved fewer days than a specified median. Median days of job transfer or restriction are represented in actual values.

<sup>3</sup> In January of 2015, the original six industries selected for the days-of-job-transfer-or-restriction (DJTR) study were replaced with a new set of six industries. The original six 3-digit industries included: Specialty trade contractors; Food manufacturing; Building material and garden equipment supplies dealers; Air transportation; Warehousing and storage; and Nursing and residential care facilities.

These codes are based on the Occupational Injury and Illness Classification System 2.01 developed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
