
The health care and social assistance sector accounted for 95 percent of all injury and illness cases within education and health services in 2004.

Hospitals alone accounted for 40 percent of all reported cases in this major industry sector in 2004, reporting more cases (284,600) than any other industry.

Nursing and residential care facilities and ambulatory health care services accounted for 30 percent and 17 percent, respectively, of cases in this major industry sector.
