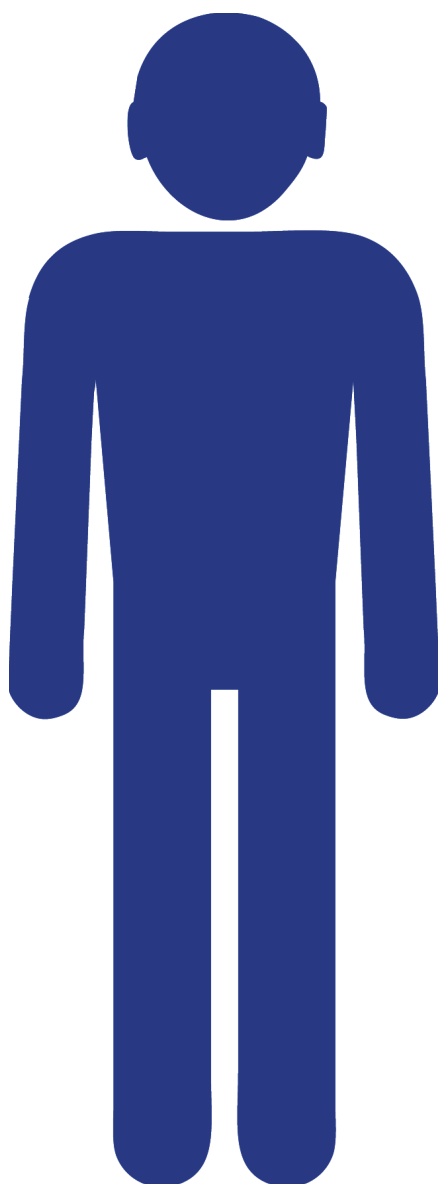


What is the Occupational Requirements Survey (ORS)?



The BLS conducts this survey under an agreement with the Social Security Administration (SSA). The goal of the ORS is to collect and publish information about specific work-related requirements that will be available to the public and used by SSA to help make decisions for their disability programs. Education, Training & Experience:

Minimum education, Experience, Non-degree credentials, On-the-job training



Cognitive & Mental Requirements:

People skills, Work pace, Problem solving, Control of workload



Physical Demands:

Sitting, Standing, Climbing, Reaching, Keyboarding, Lifting or carrying



Environmental Conditions:

Extreme heat or cold, Heavy vibrations, Hazardous contaminants, Outdoors, Noise level, Wetness, Humidity
