**Midwest CPI Summary**

**NOTE:** 2018 CPI Geographic Revision to affect publication of four cities in the Midwest Region.

As announced on [www.bls.gov/cpi](http://www.bls.gov/cpi), publication of the CPI for the following Midwest cities will be affected by the 2018 CPI Geographic Revision:

**Cleveland-Akron, OH; Cincinnati-Hamilton, OH-KY-IN; and Milwaukee-Racine, WI**, will no longer be published after 2017 data reference periods.

- **Cleveland**'s final release will be for the month of November 2017, scheduled for publication on December 13, 2017.
- **Cincinnati**'s and **Milwaukee**'s final releases will be for the second-half average and annual average 2017, scheduled for release on January 12, 2018.

**Minneapolis-St. Paul, MN-WI**, will go from semi-annual publication to bi-monthly publication. It will be published for the odd numbered months starting with January 2018 data in February 2018.
