### Midwest CPI Summary

**NOTE:** 2018 CPI Geographic Revision to affect publication of four cities in the Midwest Region.

As announced on [www.bls.gov/cpi](http://www.bls.gov/cpi), publication of the CPI for the following Midwest cities was affected by the 2018 CPI Geographic Revision:

**Cleveland-Akron, OH; Cincinnati-Hamilton, OH-KY-IN; and Milwaukee-Racine, WI**, are no longer published.

- **Cleveland**'s final release was for the month of November 2017, and was published on December 13, 2017.
- **Cincinnati**'s and **Milwaukee**'s final releases for the second-half average and annual average 2017 were published on January 12, 2018.

**Minneapolis-St. Paul, MN-WI**, has gone from a semi-annual publication to a bi-monthly publication. It is published for the odd numbered months starting with January 2018 data in February 2018.
