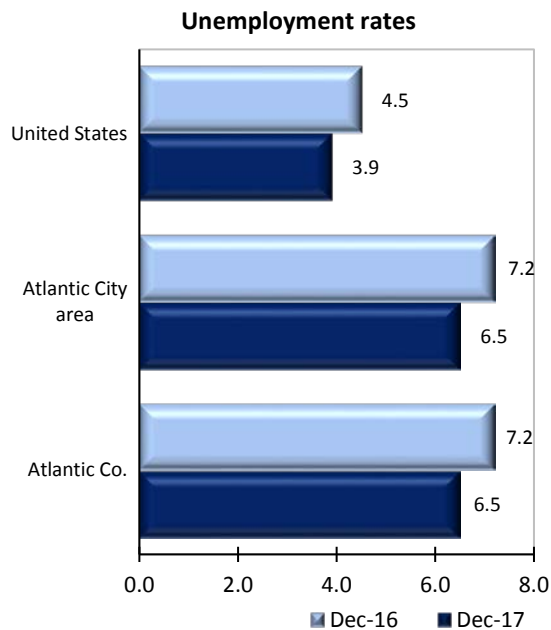


Atlantic City Area Economic Summary

Average weekly wages for all industries by county

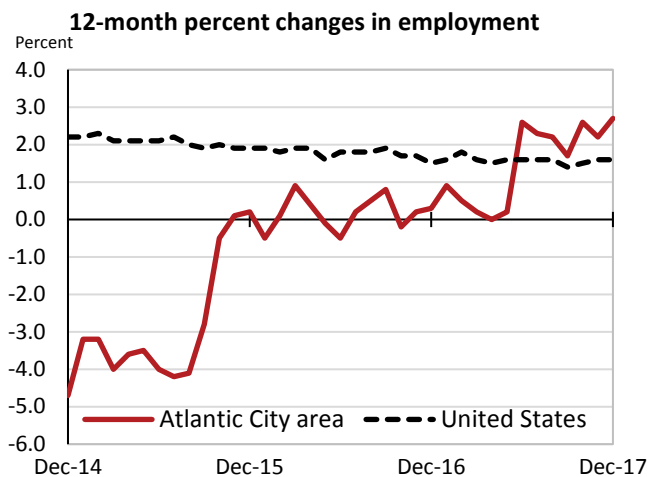
Atlantic City area, 2nd quarter 2017

Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector

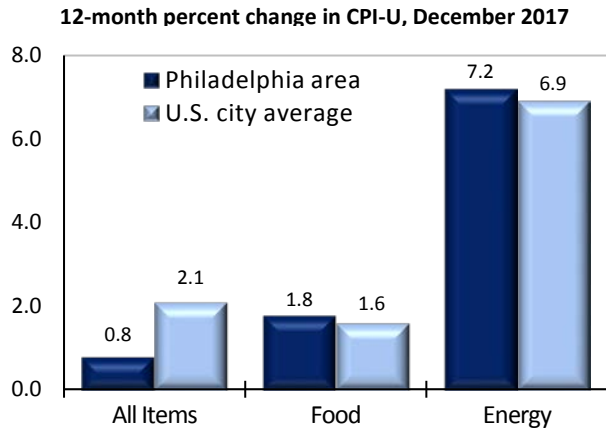

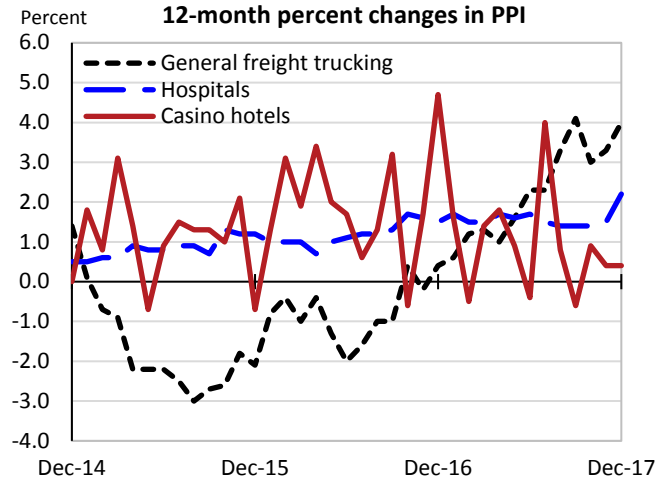

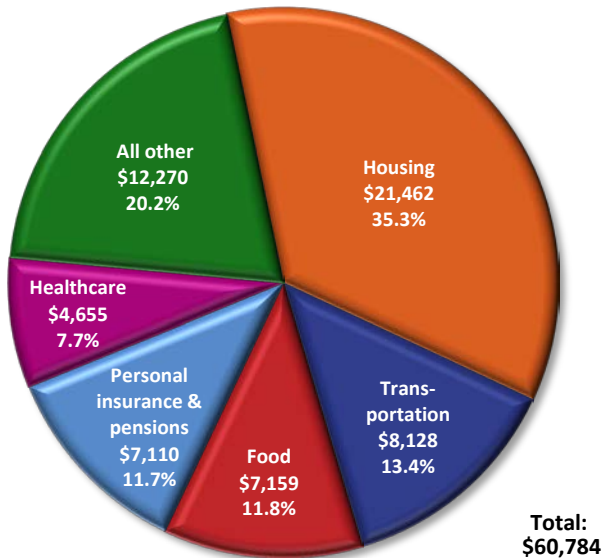
Over-the-year changes in the selling prices received by producers for selected industries nationwide

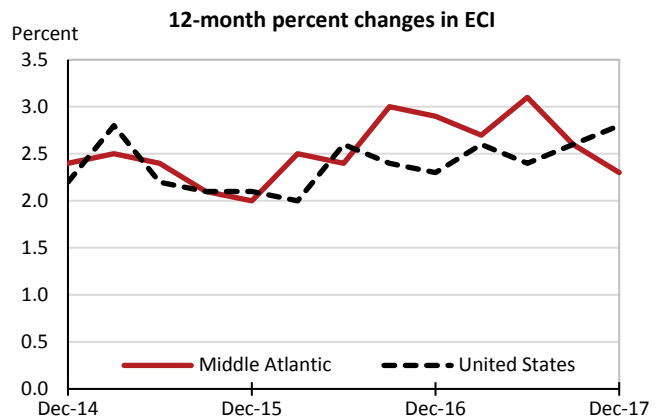
