

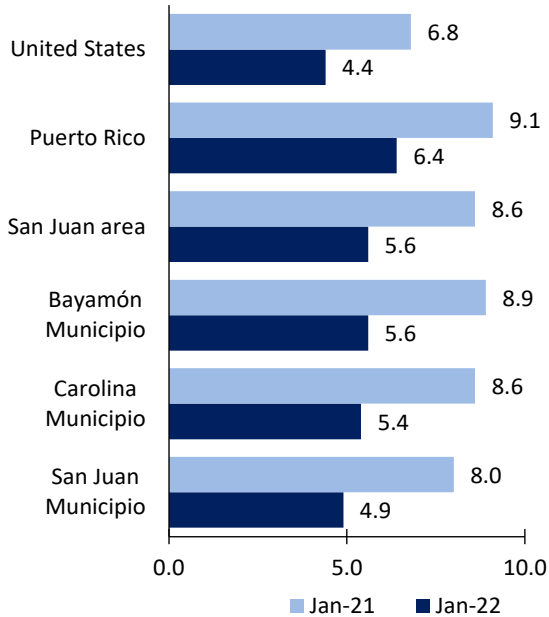
San Juan Area Economic Summary

Unemployment rates

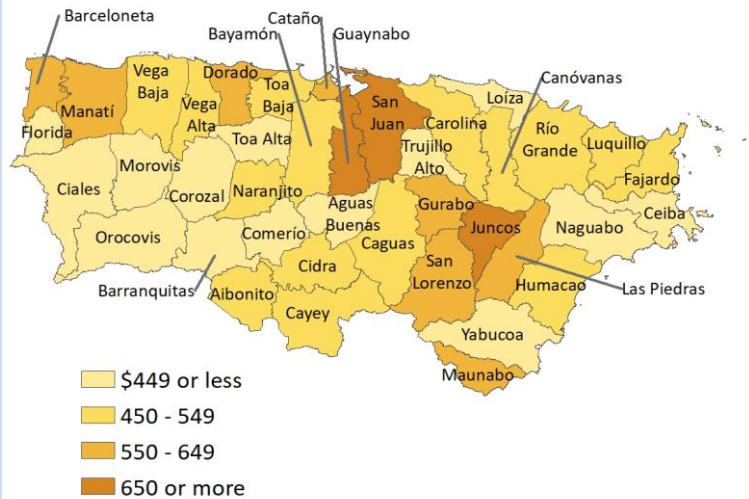

San Juan area, third quarter 2021

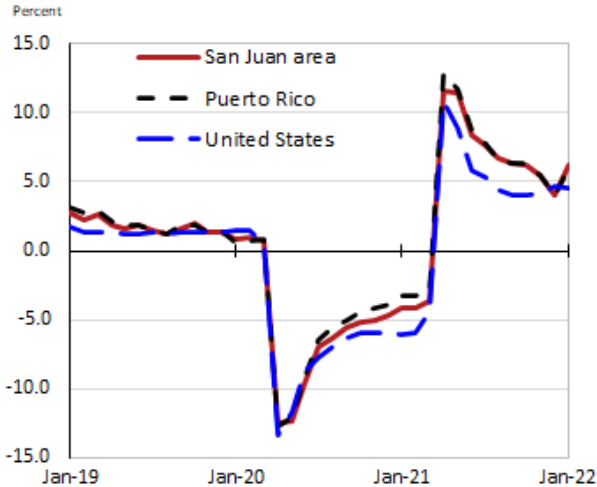
