
## Orange-Rockland-Westchester Area Economic Summary


Employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector, over-the-year changes






















Employer costs per hour worked for wages and selected

<u>Selling prices received by producers</u> for selected industries nationwide, over-the-year change




