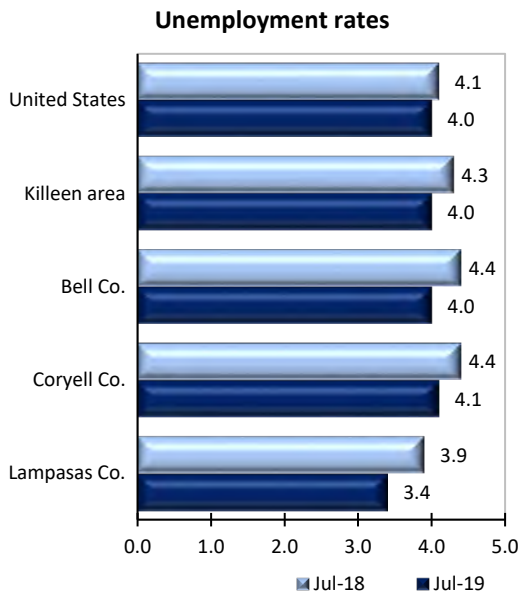


Killeen Area Economic Summary

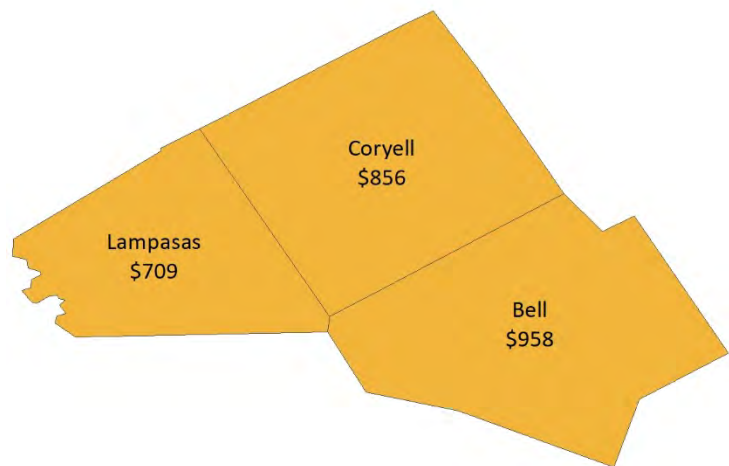
Unemployment rates for the Killeen area, selected area counties, and the nation

Average weekly wages for all industries by county

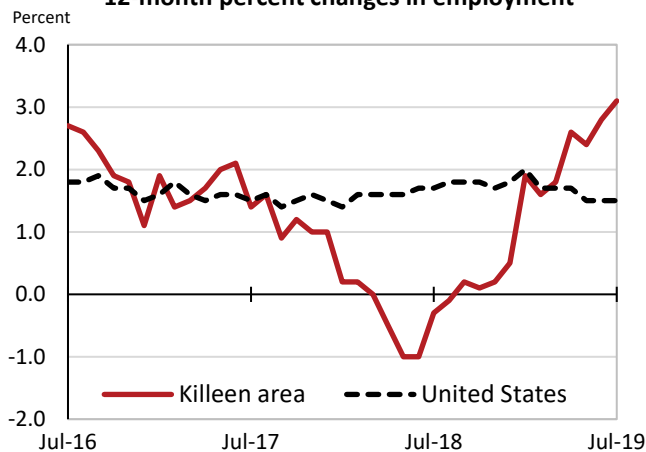
Killeen area, 4th quarter 2018

12-month percent changes in employment



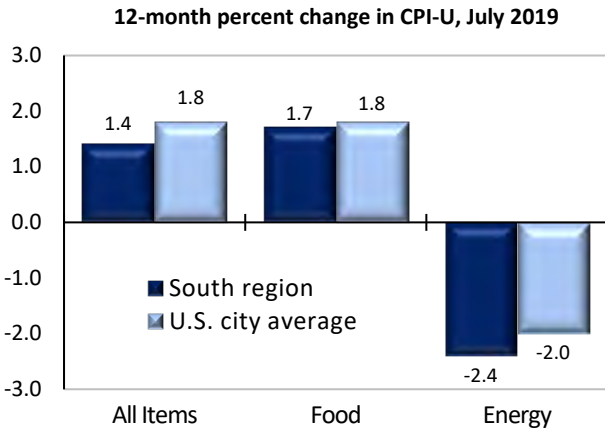

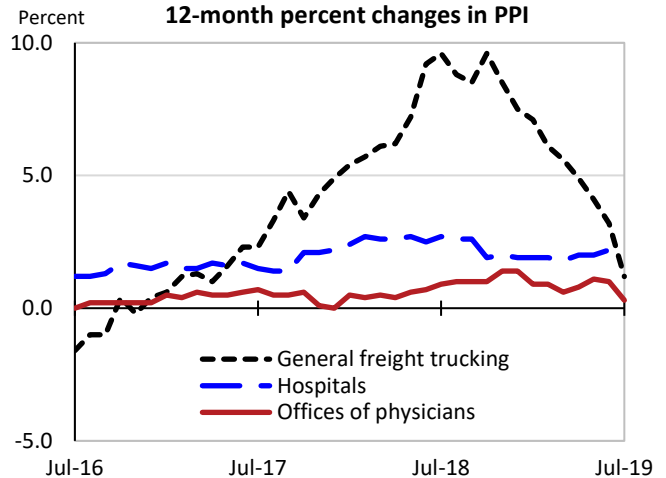


Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories

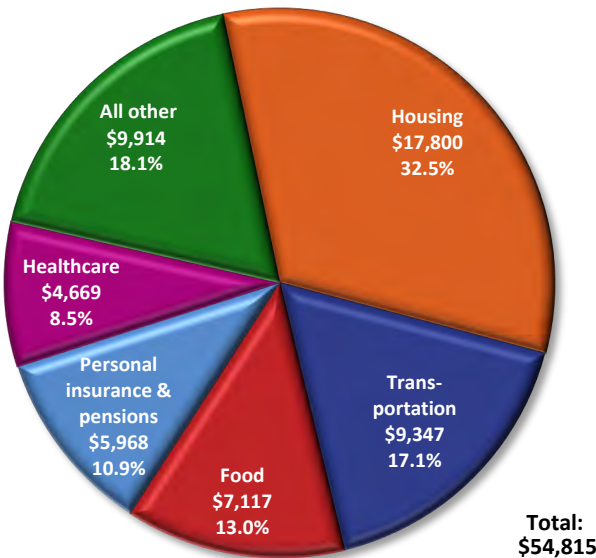
Over-the-year changes in the selling prices received by producers for selected industries nationwide

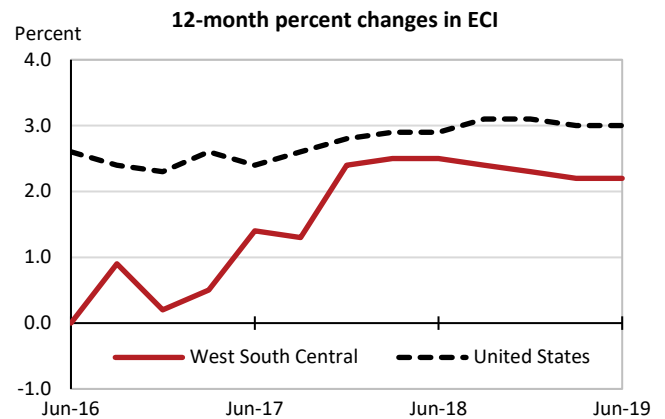
