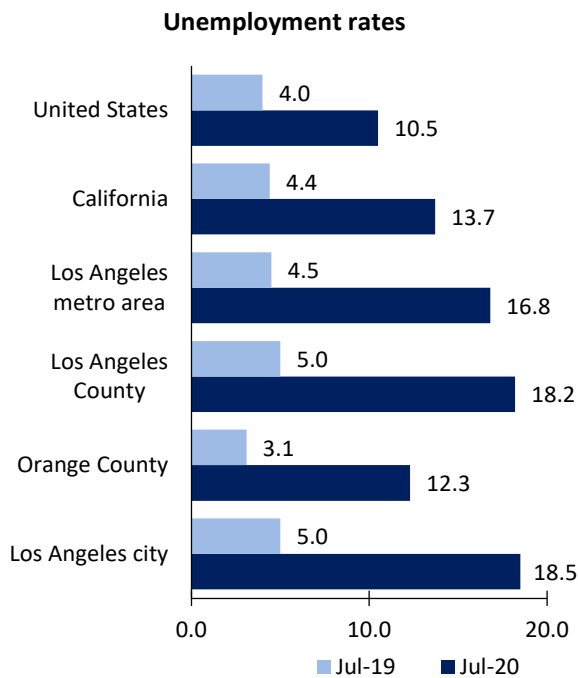


Los Angeles Area Economic Summary

Average weekly wages for all industries by county

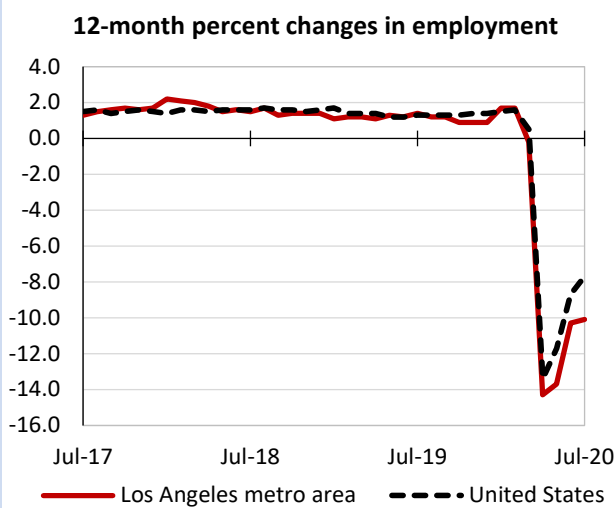
Los Angeles metro area, first quarter 2020

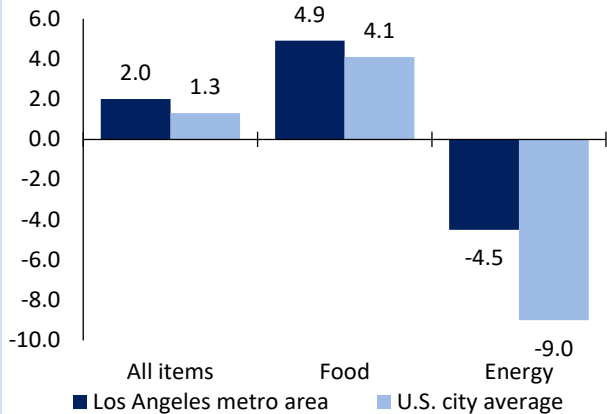

Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories

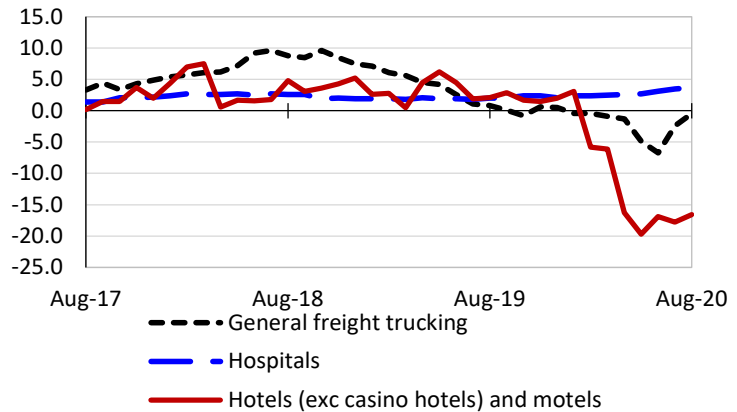
12-month percent change in CPI-U, August 2020

Over-the-year changes in the selling prices received by producers for selected industries nationwide

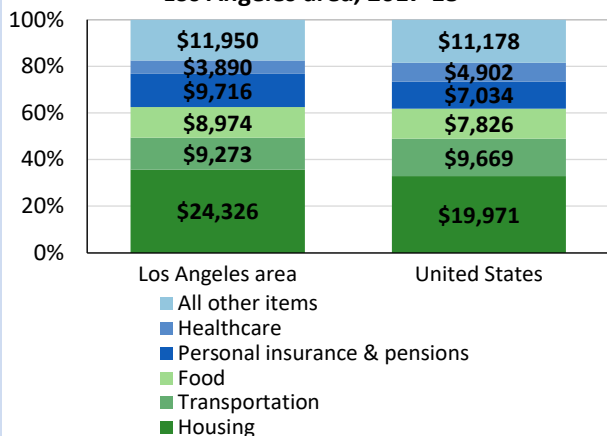
12-month percent changes in PPI

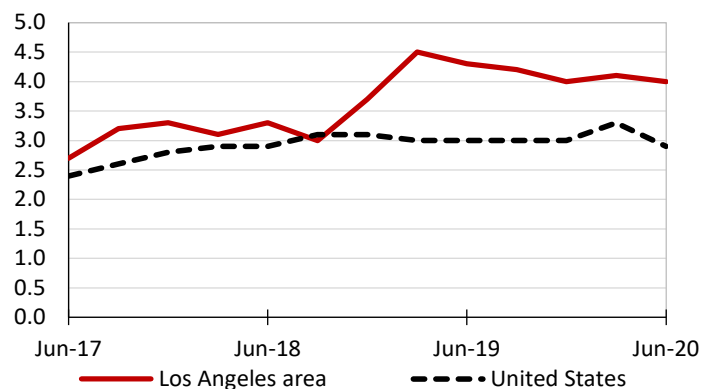
